To ensure that the City of Fairburn's Emergency Warning System functions properly when needed, the City will be conducting monthly siren tests. Utilizing new digitally secure radio technology, the Emergency Warning Siren System will be activated biannually. Additionally, the City of Fairburn will participate in the statewide tornado drill in the month of February.
