

Because of its strategic location, Fairburn is home to several national brand companies including, NestlePurina, US Foods, S.C. Johnson, Clorox, Electrolux, Aaron Rents as well as Smuckers and Google.

Georgia's emergence as an important hub for the film and entertainment industry has attracted a major production studio. Pinewood Atlanta Studio has its South Fulton location just minutes from Fairburn.

Since 1985 the Georgia Renaissance Festival has operated in Fairburn. This nationally recognized event draws a quarter million attendees annually and was voted one of the top 20 events in the Southeast.

Fairburn's history as a railroad town still benefits the City's economic vitality. The CSX rail line provides access to their growing intermodal yard.

Residential living in Fairburn offers opportunities in new, upscale subdivisions; older historic homes near downtown; or home sites in a rural setting.

Clarence L. Duncan Community Park, the City's primary open space and recreation amenity, provides residents and visitors with a variety of active and passive recreation opportunities. Since 2010, the City has invested nearly \$7 million in improvements to the park along with contributions from its hometown hero, all-pro NFL player Eric Berry.
