# TAX TIME

## Your Taxes:

What additional fees are charged due to non-payment or late payment?

All taxes remaining unpaid after the due date of December 15<sup>th</sup> are considered delinquent and are subject to interest charges.

1% interest is added on January 1<sup>st</sup> and each month thereafter until paid.

A ten percent (10%) tax penalty accrues ninety (90) days after the due date. This means it could be added on March 16 which is 90 days after the due date of December 15<sup>th</sup>.

We will assess this penalty on April 1<sup>st</sup>.

Additional fees and cost accrue as collection actions are taken.

Collections fee are charged as they are incurred.

Tax liens are sold on the first Tuesday in September of each year.

The location of the sale is the Council Chambers in Fairburn City Hall.


