The current project is investigating how to maximize the unique configuration of downtown Fairburn as well as connecting to key stakeholders in the area. These transportation improvements will complement the signature public and private investments the City has experienced recently and will attract more activity to our historic downtown.

The purpose of the Open House is to obtain feedback from citizens and other stakeholders on existing design concepts developed during previous phases and from feedback obtained from the public.
