

Oakley Industrial Boulevard & Bohannon Road Full-Depth Reclamation (FDR) Project

The reclamation activities for the Oakley Industrial Boulevard & Bohannon Road Full-Depth Reclamation Project is scheduled to begin Wednesday, August 22nd, 2018.

The Contractor plans to spend two days milling and potholing the utilities, then they will start mixing the roadway. Depending on weather, the Contractor can complete the reclamation work within two weeks.

Road closures will not be allowed; however temporary lane closures are allowed from 9am to 4pm. The Contractor will be allowed to mill each road 100%, however, the Contractor will be required to maintain proper traffic control in accordance with MUTCD Standards, as well as maintaining proper drainage along the roadway during construction while the interim surface elevation is below grade.

No resident or business shall be denied vehicular access to their property for any length of time other than that which is absolutely necessary, and as determined the City Engineer.

Please note that in order to expedite project completion, weekend work activities have been approved. Upon completion of the construction activities on Oakley Industrial Boulevard, the Contractor will move to East Broad Street/McLarin Road for the proposed reclamation work scheduled for section of the roadway that extends from Bohannon Road to Senoia Road.
