

Any person can “file” a complaint against, or a commendation for, an officer of the Fairburn Police Department.

In the event that an individual has a complaint against, or a commendation for, a Fairburn Police Officer, there are several methods of presenting or filing their complaint or commendation.

- The complaint/commendation can be made in person by coming to the Fairburn Police Department Monday through Friday 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM and speaking with the Officer’s Supervisor, or the Internal Affairs Supervisor
- The complaint/commendation can be made by telephone at (770) 964-1441 and speaking with the Officer’s supervisor.
- The complaint/commendation can be made to the Department Internal Affairs Investigator at (770) 683-4094
- The complaint/commendation can be made on the internet with the Internal Affairs Investigator at:

- The complaint/commendation can be made by obtaining a complaint form from the officers supervisor or from the front desk at the Fairburn Police Department

Regardless of how you decide to make a complaint, you will likely be asked to come into the Police Department to put your complaint in writing. This is to give the person who will be investigating the incident, a formal basis to conduct the investigation.

Having first hand knowledge of the incident is always preferred. If you wish to file a complaint regarding an incident that happened to someone else, we will take the complaint, but will need the individual involved in the incident to make a statement. This will aid us in obtaining factual information allowing us to interview those directly involved in the incident.

The Fairburn Police Department takes every complaint made against a Police Officer very seriously. All complaints are investigated thoroughly and all sustained complaints are handled through the agency’s disciplinary procedures.

With your assistance, the Fairburn Police Department will continue to strive to be the best Police Department in Fulton County.
