Honorable Mayor Carr-Hurst:

The November 3rd presidential election is a few weeks away. As you are aware, the Fulton County Board of Elections has made some changes to the polling locations in your city. Below is a list reflecting those changes. The purpose of the changes is to decrease voter wait times. Precinct changes were instituted if the voter count exceeded 5,000. Please refer to the notes section below for further explanation of precinct changes, relocations, and splits.
