Utility Amnesty Program

In an effort to assist customers in bringing their utility payments up to date, the City of Fairburn is offering a one-time Utility Amnesty Program. During the months of September and October only, for customers who have a delinquent utility account, the City will waive up to three months of delinquent penalties and administrative fees and spread the remaining balance over three equal installments. One third will be due at that time, with the other two-thirds spread out over the next two utility bills. You must sign a payment arrangement which will indicate the installment amount to be paid in addition to the current charges, and agree to pay the utility bills by the due date to avoid accumulating future late fees and administrative fees.
