The successful Contractor will be required to coordinate with the Owner for the exact locations. The cost for this work should be captured in the Grading Complete line item.
- 8. What are the allowable work hours for this project?

- 9. Who is responsible for paying testing? The successful Contractor.

 Plans reference a geotechnical report to be completed along with a structural design for pavilion base by the Contractor. The successful Contractor shall complete Geotechnical report and supply shop drawings by a structural engineering showing design for base of pavilion structures.

12. Does the city accept another vendor besides RCP shelters?

The site plan states, "or approved equal". A non-RCP shelter design may be provided to City for review and approval prior to bid.
