

CITY OF FAIRBURN ART ADVISORY COUNCIL

PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES:

The City of Fairburn Art Advisory Council's purpose is to provide strategic input and recommendations to the Mayor, City Council and City Staff on matters pertaining to public art in the City of Fairburn.

The Fairburn Art Advisory Council's objectives are to:

- 1. Serve as the City's review body for public art projects throughout the City;
- 2. Provide feedback to Staff on the assessment of current and future needs of art for the purpose of program and facility planning; and
- 3. Serve as a resource and advocate to/for the City on a wide range of visual and performing arts programing and work with the city to promote arts in the City of Fairburn

COMPOSITION:

The City of Fairburn Art Advisory Council consists of seven (7) members having one or more of the following qualifications: a professional in the field of art, landscape architect, urban planning, historian, residential or business citizen of the City of Fairburn. Members will be chosen for their demonstrated background, education and expertise in the arts (i.e. visual, performing, media, literary), art history, art critic, architecture or related professions.

TERM:

Members will serve four-year terms. Initial appointments shall be two members for one year; two members for two years; and three members for four years. Members do not receive a salary but will be reimbursed for authorized expenses directly incurred in the performance of duties related the Art Advisory Council.

MEETINGS:

The official meeting date and time of the Council will be determined once the council membership has been established. Four members present shall constitute a quorum. A quorum shall be required for the Council to conduct any business.

POWERS & DUTIES:

The City of Fairburn Art Advisory Council powers and duties are as follows:

- To review and make recommendations to the Mayor, City Council, and City Staff on all public art projects throughout the City;
- To evaluate the art landscape of Fairburn to identify potential art projects, and provide recommendations on projects, partnerships and programing related to all facets of art; and
- Review options for public arts initiatives, seek grant funding opportunities, advocate and promote the arts in the City of Fairburn.
