The following plans are required for submittal:

- Deck/porch details
- Elevations
- Floor framing
- Floor plan
- Foundation plan
- Roof plan
- Wall Section
- Survey

\$150 Residential plan review fee applicable

Permits are only issued after all reviews are completed, approved and all fees are paid. The time required to conduct this review will depend on the completeness of the information we receive at application.

Residential Plan Review

Building plan review is necessary to determine if your project is in compliance with local and state building codes, the zoning ordinance and other county and state ordinances and/or regulations. The residential plan review is done simultaneously with all other required reviews; therefore, it will not extend the time in which it takes for your permit to be approved.

Construction Codes
