WHEN ARE BUILDING PERMITS REQUIRED?

Many construction and home improvement projects require a building permit. The list below covers some common residential projects. If your project does not appear on the list, please contact a member of our permitting staff at 770-964-2244 x401, to determine if a permit is required.

Exempt Work – a permit is not required for painting or general repairs with costs under \$200.00. This may be repair and maintenance work, such as receptacle replacement, fixture replacement (sinks, stools, lighting fixtures) and vanities.

- Decks and Deck repairs
- Demolition
- Electrical Reconnects
- Emergency Generators
- Fence (over 40" high)
- Finishing basements
- Fire Damage
- HVAC replacements
- Interior and exterior alterations
- ING PERMIT Interior replacements and repairs
- New homes
- This card must be kept posted in a conspicuous place on site of New or altered plumbing work
- Patio/ Screen Porch
- Fountains, Pools, Spas & Hot tubs (containing 24" of water or more)
- Re-Roofina
- Retaining Walls (over 4' in height)
- Sheds & Accessory Structures (over 100 sq. ft.)
- Solar Panels
- Window and siding Replacement
