FINAL UTILITY CREDIT NOTIFICATION

We would like to inform you that the final credit adjustment for your water and electric services, covering the period of December 2023 to January 2024, will be applied to your August bill. This comprehensive adjustment was calculated to provide the difference between billing rates before and after January 1, 2024, and provides the appropriate adjustment for the December 2023 billing cycle dates. This reflects our commitment to transparency and accuracy in our billing processes, ensuring that you receive the appropriate credits for the services rendered.

CREDIT DETAILS

- Electric Service:**
- A credit of 5.4% will be applied to your electric service bill.
- Water Service:**
- For residents 100-80 (water, residential outside), a credit of 2.63% will be applied to your water service bill.
 - For residents 100-81 (water, residential inside), a credit of 2.68% will be applied to your water service bill.

WHAT THIS MEANS FOR YOU

- The credits will appear as a line item on your August bill, reducing the overall amount due.
- This adjustment is a one-time credit reflecting the reconciliation of services provided during the specified period.
