

Program Description

The Low-Income Home Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP) is available to all income eligible households in Fulton County and the City of Atlanta. This program offers a payment of \$200 or \$300 once per program year to be applied to your household drinking or sewage bill. Applicants must be a customer of an approved vendor. The list of approved vendors can be found on our website.

<u>will be conducted over the phone.</u>

Required documents include:

- Current water bill
- Proof of income for the last 30 days for all occupants over 18
- Social Security cards for all household members
- Valid Photo ID (Driver's License, Permanent Resident Card, Passport, etc.)

TO PREVENT DELAYS IN PROCESSING YOUR APPLICATION, UPLOAD YOUR DOCUMENTS ONE WEEK BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT DATE

(Must have appointment to upload)
