

City of Fairburn – Water Conservation Retrofit Kit Program

Purpose: The intent of the Retrofit program is to encourage a permanent reduction in the amount of water used inside the home.

Contents:

- 1- Instruction sheet
- 1- Earth™ Massage Showerhead, 1.5 gallons per minute (gpm)
- 2- Faucet aerators, 1.0 gpm
- 1- Toilet tank displacement bags
- 1- Toilet fill cycle clamps
- 2- Leak detecting dye tablets
- 1- Shower Coach® ShowerTimer
- 1- Kitchen swivel spray/stream aerator with pause function, 1.5 gpm
- 1- Teflon tape
- 1- Flow Meter Bag

Requirements: An account holder will be eligible to receive a kit if he/she meets the following qualifications:

1. A City of Fairburn residential water customer (not stormwater or trash-only); and
2. Home built prior to 1993 and the house must have plumbing fixtures that have not been updated to today's water efficiency standards.
3. Quantities are limited to one Retrofit kit per household and are only available to residential single-family homes with an individual billing account.

Procedure: You may request a kit online or by calling (770) 969-3481. The Customer Service staff will review your request and if approved, call you to schedule an appointment for you to pick up your kit. A City of Fairburn employee may visit your property to view the installed water saving devices.

Please note: Quantities are limited to one Retrofit kit per household and are only available to residential single-family homes with an individual billing account. Kits will be given on a first come, first served basis from the date and time the request is received. Requests received after kits have been expended will be prioritized for future availability (waiting list).
