CITIZENS POLICE ACADEMY IMPORTANT INFORMATION



PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

1. Please complete the Application for Enrollment form in its entirety. Class members must be at least 21 years of age and a resident, local business owner, or employed with the City of Fairburn. Applicants must have no felony convictions; or applicant must have no misdemeanor convictions within one year of application.
2. All applicants will be subject to a criminal history check as a precondition to acceptance into the Academy. Return applications in person to the Police Department front desk, or mail to Fairburn Police Department, 191 SW Broad Street, Fairburn, Georgia 30213 (ATTN: Sgt. E. DeSantos), or email edesantos@Fairburn.com.
3. The Chief of Police has final approval of all applicants and reserves the right to deny entry to any applicant. Accepted applicants will be notified by email and/or telephone.
4. The Academy is free of charge to all members. Class size is limited to the first 25 qualified applicants.
5. Dress attire for class is casual. (No shorts, halters, etc.) Name badges will be provided and should be worn to all class sessions.
6. Qualified applicants who are denied admission due to class size will be given first choice when the next Academy session is scheduled.
7. The Release of Liability Statement form must be signed and returned with the completed application.
8. Classes will be held in the Council Chambers of City Hall located at 56 Malone Street SW, Fairburn, Georgia, 30213.
9. Classes will be held on Thursday evenings from 6:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M.
