**The City of Fairburn Encourages Community Members to "Clean House"
and Attend FREE Spring Clean Up & Document Shred-It Events**

The City of Fairburn will host an Annual Spring Clean Up this Friday and Saturday, April 22nd & 23rd and a Free Document Shred-It Event on Saturday, April 23rd. Both events offer residents the opportunity to dispose of household waste at no charge.

"This is something we do as a service to the community, giving people an opportunity to help maintain their community while also disposing of household items and hazardous waste properly, without concern about damaging the local environment," said Mayor Mario B. Avery.

The Annual Spring Clean Up, which will be held on Friday and Saturday, April 22nd & 23rd at 102 Howell Avenue, Fairburn, GA 30213 from 9:00AM - 4:00PM both days, is a service for residents of the City of Fairburn only and proof of residency will be required (i.e., driver's license, power bill, voter registration card).

Accepted materials include:

- Materials generated from your home, appliances (no Freon), e-waste, anything that requires a plug or battery to operate
- Bulk items such as furniture, carpet, mattresses, toilets, etc.
- Cell phones and accessories, ink/toner, computers, printers, tv's, monitors
- Only 15 tires per residence will be accepted

Hazardous materials accepted include:

- Household paints (latex & oil), oven cleaners
- Cooking oil/grease, aerosols, bleaches & chlorine, drain cleansers, pesticides & herbicides
- Automotive & household batteries, motor oil, transmission fluid, antifreeze, paint thinner
- Wood strippers, insect sprays, rodent killers, fluorescent bulbs

The Free Document Shred-It Event Day will also be held on Saturday, April 23rd in the Fairburn City Hall parking lot at 56 Malone St., Fairburn, GA 30213 from 9:00AM - 2:00PM. Bring your personal and confidential papers to Fairburn City Hall. Documents will be shredded on-site and recycled.

The City will accept:

- Documents such as pamphlets, leaflets, files, journals, and paper products
- CDs, floppy disks, and other media will be accepted
- Staples, paper clips, and rubber bands do not have to be removed
- Please **REMOVE** 3-ring binders, large binder clips, plastics, or metals
- **DO NOT** tape boxes shut as it slows down the process

"I encourage every single resident, business owner and community member to participate in these events," said City Administrator Tony M. Phillips. "This gives the City another opportunity to elevate our quality of life by promoting a clean community for all Fairburn residents."
