In the evening hours, the panels are illuminated with bright light, providing safe passage through the city center. - Only 4 tires per residence
- Hazardous Materials Accepted:
 - Household paints (latex & oil) oven cleaners, cooking oil/grease, aerosols, bleaches & chlorine, drain cleaners, pesticides & herbicides, automotive & household batteries, motor oil, transmission fluid, antifreeze, paint thinner, wood strippers, insect sprays, & rodent killers, fluorescent bulbs

LIMBS SHALL NOT EXCEED 1 PILE (6 FT LONG) X (4 FT WIDE) X (4 FT HIGH) X (6 IN IN DIAMETER)

PILES MUST BE PLACED ALONG ROAD OR DRIVEWAY FRONTAGE

- No nails, wires, or any metal pieces
- No firewood, logs, stumps, or roots
- No leaves or grass
- No spiny plants, roses, etc.
- No construction wood of any type (i.e. fences, decks)

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH GUIDELINES WILL RESULT IN ITEMS NOT CHIPPED
