Sec. 8-115. – Reports of sales to be made quarterly, suspension, revocation.

- (a) Licensees shall, within 30 days following the end of each quarter, file with the city clerk a report sworn to be the licensee, setting forth gross sales of the licensee for the quarter, sales of food and nonalcoholic beverages, and sales of alcoholic beverages.
- (b) Should the total sales from food and nonalcoholic beverages reported by any licensee for consumption on the premises not exceed those from the sale of all alcoholic beverages as required by this chapter for any two consecutive reporting periods, the license may be suspended or revoked by the mayor and council after a hearing as provided for in article V of this chapter.

Sec. 8-155. - Same—From mayor and council's decision.

Appeals from an action by the mayor and council to affirm the decision of the city administrator to deny a license or to revoke or suspend a license pursuant to this article shall be by writ of certiorari to the superior court of the county.
