TYPES OF SMALL BUSINESS GRANTS

Capital Improvement Grants

Eligible small businesses looking to renovate or expand their businesses can apply for up to \$25,000 in funding through ARPA for capital improvement projects.

Relocation Assistance

Eligible small businesses can receive up to \$25,000 in relocation expenses when moving their business to a new location.

Small Business Incubator

Eligible new businesses that have been operational for a year or less, can receive up to \$5,000 under this program.

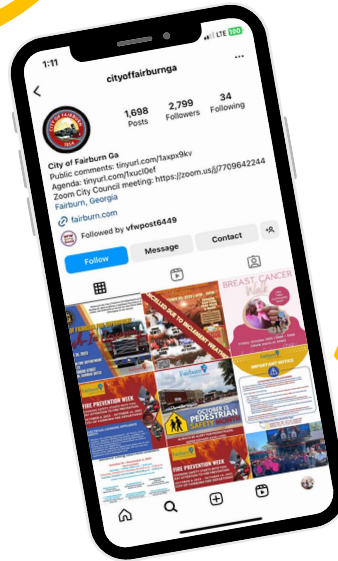
Payroll Assistance Program

Eligible small businesses may apply for up to \$10,000 to bring outstanding payroll current and for future payroll including employee benefit expenses.

Rent Assistance Program

Eligible applicants can receive up to \$5,000 to cover commercial rent expenses.
