The City is also improving our online utility payment portal, and it will be fully operational by April 1.

I hope you stay safe and continue to mask up, secure an appointment for your vaccination, if you have not done so, and remember to social distance when out in public.

ERRONEOUS BILLING



"The Utilities Department identified some Utilities meter file errors during last month's billing.

We have been reviewing accounts and

making the appropriate adjustments (deemed necessary). Fortunately, this system glitch did not affect all of your accounts. However, we are encouraging customers to contact our office for a review if their consumption seems higher than normal. We kindly ask for a review period of 2-3 business days. The staff is working diligently to improve our processes and software to better service the great citizens of Fairburn. PAYMENT OPTIONS

"We are now accepting payments through the new online payment portal; Insite. In order to enroll, you must have your new account number (including the dashes), along with your last payment amount. If you need this information for enrollment, please contact our office. The link for enrollment is:

https://www.municipalonlinepayments.com/fairburnga. In addition, there is a new payment option for customers to pay over the phone using an IVR service. You will need your full account and the street # of the address. There is a convenience fee (charged from the merchant) of \$1.25 per transaction, for both of these payment options."

AUTO PAY OPTION

"During the migration of the billing system, we changed our online payment portal as well. Unfortunately, we were unable to mirror all of the existing online enrollments to the new portal. For security purposes, we wanted to ensure that all sensitive information (bank account numbers, credit/debit card information, etc.) was not corrupted during any files transfers. Therefore, we are requesting for all customers to re-enroll on the new portal for the different methods of payment. Once enrolled, you will have the option to pay with a debit/credit card, or re-enroll in Auto Pay. In addition, there is a new payment option for customers to pay over the phone using an IVR service. There is a convenience fee (charged from the merchant) of \$1.25 per transaction, for all of these payment options."
